TRICITY

is a metropolitan area in Pomeranian Voivodeship consisting of three contiguous coastal cities in Pomerania forming a row on the coastline of the Gdańsk Bay, Baltic Sea, namely the cities of Gdańsk, Gdynia, Sopot, and other cities and towns in their vicinity. In 2021, the three core cities were inhabited by 749 786 people, while Tricity and its metropolitan area had a combined population of between 1 and 1.5 million.

GDAŃSK

is an old, historic city reaching back more than 1000 years. Full of breathtaking architecture, stunning history and excellent venues, Gdańsk is one of the most popular tourist destinations in Poland. It can be easily and directly accessed by air from over 70 locations in Europe. It is a rapidly-growing university and commercial hub inhabited by nearly 500,000 people, situated on Gdańsk Bay on the southern shores of the Baltic Sea.

TRANSPORT

The entire Tricity is very well connected and intertwines seamlessly from one city to another. Therefore, it is easy to **travel and explore** all three cities. It takes up to an hour to drive from Gdańsk to Gdynia.

In addition to many apps with taxi providers, we have many **e-scooter networks** allowing you to get faster to your destination.

If you prefer public transport, all the three cities are well connected by SKM - Tricity Rapid Rail - which takes you along the main road and allows you to visit most of the tourist attractions within walking distance of the station. Any further excursions may be easily made thanks to a network of buses and trams.



TRANSPORT TO UG



The nearest tram stops to the campus: "Uniwersytet Gdański" and "Bażyńskiego" (trams number 2, 4, 5, 6, 8, 12).



The nearest bus stops to the campus: "**Przymorze SKM**" (buses number 199, 249, 149) and "**Biblioteka UG**" (buses number 199, 122).



All 3 cities are well connected by **SKM – Tricity Rapid Rail.** The nearest SKM stop to the UG is **"Gdańsk Przymorze Uniwersytet**". The Tricity is served by only one SKM line.
